BEACH SPRING: As A Fire is Meant For Burning
NETTLETON: Come Thou Fount of Every Blessing
HYFRYDOL: Love Divine, All Loves Excelling
HYMN TO JOY: Joyful, Joyful, We Adore Thee

Vs. I extol my Lord and savior,
for he came to rescue me:
And the Lord has not permitted
vict'ry for my enemies.
God, you brought me forth from Sheol,
saved me from the depths of hell:
You have healed and saved my life, that
in the pit I may not fall.

← This verse sets not only vs 1 (as appointed) but vs 2 of Ps 30, which is very appropriate to the feast.

Dox. Glory be to God the Father,
Glory be to God the Son,
Glory be to God the Spirit,
Glory to the Three in One.
From the heart of blessed Mary,
From all saints the song ascends,
And the church the strain re-echoes
Unto earth's remotest ends.

← you can use this doxology from *Sing of Mary, Pure and Lowly* as verse 3, and then return to the antiphon as verse 4
