ENTRANCE ANTIPHON Mt 4: 18,19

Dominus secus mare

And Jesus, walking by the Sea of Galilee, saw two brethren, Simon called Peter and Andrew, his brother, and he said unto them: Follow me, and I will make you fishers of men.

The first line contains 9 syllables. While there are many more 8787D tunes, it makes most sense with these 2 tunes because there are enough notes to naturally include the extra syllable.

Adorate Deum

All angels bow down before him. Zion has heard and is glad;
and the daughters of Judah have heard and rejoiced.

Ant. All angels bow before the Lord.
Glad Zion hears with praise outpoured.
All Judah's daughters raise their voice,
The Lord is king, let earth rejoice.

Vs. 2 Consuming fire destroys his foes,
The trembling earth his presence knows,
Around the world his lightnings blaze;
The mountains melt before his gaze.

Dox. Praise to the Lamb upon the throne,
honor and thanks to him be shown,
whom with the Father we adore,
and Holy Spirit evermore.
